



Supplemental Rules and Regulations regarding Newington Resident play at Indian Hill Country Club

- Residents playing at Indian Hill Country Club subject to all Club Rules
- **NEW for 2010:** Entering the drainage area to the left of the 2nd hole is strictly prohibited. The rocks are placed loosely and serious injury may result if entering the area. Any resident entering this area will be removed from the golf course and will be reported to the Newington Parks and Recreation Department. Rules of Golf: Play as an environment lateral water hazard.
- In order to be eligible to play Indian Hill all Residents must purchase a Resident Pass from the Indian Hill office or Golf Shop
 - Proof of residency is required
 - Fee is determined via lease
- All fees may be paid by cash or check.
- Residents are limited to playing 8 times per month.
- Senior Citizens shall be allowed to play free golf on Mondays from after 8:00 AM to 11:00 am and anytime after 1:00pm.
- Guests of Residents
 - Allowed on Sundays after 2:00pm and Mondays after 1:30pm
 - Fees will be equivalent to the Guest of Members rate
 - A resident can bring up to eight (8) guests in a month; however, a guest may only play twice a month.
- All Residents, Senior, and their Guests must check in with the Starter prior to play. In the case of golf car rental, Residents, Seniors, and their Guest must check in with the Golf Shop.
- Dress Code:
 - Collared golf shirt
 - Slacks or Bermuda length shorts
 - Not allowed to be worn
 - Cargo pants/shorts
 - T-Shirts or other non-golf shirts
 - Shorts shorter than Bermuda length

- Residents are allowed use of the practice range on Mondays only. Must provide your own golf balls.
- Clubhouse privileges are not extended to Resident Pass holders.
- Restrooms are located in the main building at the end of the main hall.
- Junior ages would be from 10 years old to 17
 - Have to be accompanied by a parent or guardian when they play.
 - Children under 10 are not allowed on the course.
- Playing 10 holes requires 18-Hole payment of green fees.
- Residents caught on the golf course without checking in or paying will be asked to leave and reported to the Newington Parks and Recreation Department.
- On Tuesdays, residents may have to vacate the course prior to 11:30 A.M. until 5:30 P.M. to allow tournaments hosted by IHCC to proceed (understanding by Newington Town Council 10/01).
- The above are to be considered points of clarification and do not in any way supersede the Town Lease.
